## - **What is model EU?**

## - **What do we offer?**

Hong Kong Model European Union 2014 offers an unprecedented opportunity to learn about the decision-making process in European Union. Participants will not only experience

the EU governance mechanisms but also act as Heads of States and/or ministers in order to acquire an in-depth understanding of individual level decision-making.

They will be exposed to interactions with diplomats representing European Union in Hong Kong. Finally, through organized seminars and trainings they will learn negotiation and research skills that will enhance their chances of employment in the future.

Each EU member state will be represented by two delegates. The winning teams will be presented with 'Best Delegation Award' by the committee composed of European diplomats in Hong Kong and faculty staff. The winners will be automatically enrolled for the top-up summer programme that includes a study trip in Brussels. Students will be provided accommodation and subsidies for the local transport and meals worth of HK\$5,000. On top of that, there will be a HK\$500 cash award for the winners. **Please be noted that international flight tickets are not included.**

Every participant will also be presented with a certificate of participation in Hong Kong Model European Union 2014.



## - **How to enroll?**

Participants of the Hong Kong Model European Union 2014 should:

- demonstrate genuine interest in European politics;
- be fluent in English language;
- have outgoing personality and be enthusiastic about the exercise;
- be full-time undergraduate, post-graduate student or exchange student of one of the four universities: Hong Kong Baptist University, University of Hong Kong, Chinese University of Hong Kong and Lingnan University.
