Hong Kong Model European Union 2013

We cordially invite you to attend the first inter-university **Hong Kong Model European Union** organized by the European Union Academic Programme Hong Kong (EUAP), with the kind assistance from the Office of the European Union to Hong Kong and Macao.

A Model European Union is a **simulation of political decision-making processes in the EU**, conducted regularly for students of European affairs in the European Parliament in Strasbourg and a number of universities and non-profit organizations around the world.

In the Hong Kong version, students from four universities (Hong Kong Baptist University, the University of Hong Kong, the Chinese University of Hong Kong and Lingnan University) will simulate the **spring session of the European Council, i.e. the meeting of Heads of Government of the EU member states**. The main topic on the agenda will be a discussion of the "Europe 2020" strategy of the Union regarding climate change and energy sustainability, therefore major planks of global cooperation and EU-China relations in the decades to come.

Aims of the Model EU

The Hong Kong Model European Union aims to educate Hong Kong students about current events and salient topics in European politics and thereby contribute to a better understanding of the European integration process and the Union's external relations with Hong Kong and China.

What does the Model European Union offer to students and observers?

The Hong Kong Model European Union is an unprecedented opportunity to become familiar with the complex decision-making processes in the European Union. The participants themselves will acts as Heads of Member States in the discussion of future common policies of the Union.

A series of five preceding training seminars were held for the participants by the Model EU coordinator Dr. Krzysztof Sliwinski so as to familiarize students with the topics of the debate and to hone their negotiation and research skills. "These trainings have been intensive, so participants have worked very hard to prepare themselves for the final simulation. Some have taken it to the 'extreme' - to the enjoyment of all of us involved. After all, how often do you get to act as a Head of Government?" noted Dr. Sliwinski, Assistant Professor of European Politics at the Department of Government and International Studies at HK Baptist University.

The three best participants in the simulation will be awarded as "Outstanding Heads of Government" and will also be able to visit European Union institutions in a week-long EUAP summer programme in Brussels / Belgium.

香港模擬歐洲聯盟 2013

為提高參加者的研究和談判技巧,香港模擬歐洲聯盟的負責人 Dr. Sliwinski Krzysztof 為參與者度身訂做了一系列熱身活動。進行實際模擬之前,參加者連續 5 個週末參加了不同的研討會和訓練。他們亦有機會跟代表歐盟成員國的外交官員見面及互動。壓軸的實際模擬環節將於 2013 年 4 月 13 日舉行,實不容錯過。
